2010 Signage Challenge Grants

Landmark Towns of Bucks County is pleased to announce that \$10,000 will be available for a new Signage Challenge Grant Program in Bristol, Morrisville, New Hope, and Yardley Boroughs. The program will provide up to \$500 of matching funds for individual business signs.

Eligible projects must be located within the Landmark Towns of Bucks County downtown district boundaries and must meet all local ordinances. Grants are made on a first come, first served cost reimbursement basis, following a process of application, design review and approval, and construction.

Receipt of grant awards is contingent upon meeting all local approvals and inspections and compliance with all local ordinances. Please contact your local municipal government for information regarding local signage requirements.
